She currently holds the certifications of Dental Infection Prevention and Control (OSAP/ DANB) and Certified Dental Assistant (DANB). She recently completed the Fellowship program through the American Dental Assistants Association earning the title of Fellow of the American Dental Assistants Association (FADAA). After receiving her Masters of Public Health degree from Benedictine University in 2019, she was motivated to expand her reach to support dental practices everywhere in infection control and has been able to do so through her time with Nebraska ICAP, working closely with the Nebraska DHHS and the CDC.
